



1941 - 1951

The social situation of women is especially difficult. Bombing, flight and expulsion define everyday life. "Trümmerfrauen" (rubble women) become a symbol. The first women's organisations, such as the "Berliner Frauenbund" are formed.

1949

In Bad Pyrmont, Theanolte Bähnisch founds the Deutscher Frauenring e.V.

At the same time, the new Constitution takes effect, which includes Article 3 (2&3), which Elisabeth Selbert pushed through the Parliamentary Council.

1950

To achieve social equality, the German federal government, with the approval of all the political parties, establishes the Ministry for Women.
